Quarantine requirements for importation of Soybean (*Glycine max*) seed for edible consumption and oil extraction

- 1- Presenting the valid phytosanitary certificate from the country of origin.
- 2- Germination ability of the seeds should reach down to 25% with current methods at the country of origin and it shall be confirmed by a reliable international inspection company and provide the quarantine experts in the border with the relevant certificate.
- 3- Performing at the entry port and before clearance the mandatory tests regarding germination and lack of pollutions which may cause damage to the consignment.
- 4- The consignment shall be free of any soil, plant remains, and seed of weeds, live insects and disease signs.
- 5- If the consignment was exported through a third country, it shall also bear phytosanitary certificate for re-export from the relevant organization of the third country and copy of phytosanitary certificate issued by the producer country of origin sealed by quarantine authority of re-exporting country and confirmed certificate indicating lack of germination to be sealed as well by quarantine authority of re-exporting country.
- 6- Transferring the consignment to domestic customs is only allowed after surveying and approving the original necessary documentation in the entrance customs.
- 7- If quarantine infection is seen, the consignment will be returned or eradicated according to international regulations.
