Dear Readers.

This is the fourth edition of "KRUS in figures 2020–2022" statistical brochure describing the operations of the Agricultural Social Insurance Fund

This publication is a comprehensive source of knowledge about the way the system of social insurance of farmers operates in Poland. The following five chapters present figures related to the implementation of our statutory tasks.

This edition presents key information which demonstrates directions of development of the Fund that result, among others, from the introduction of favourable amendments to the Act on Social Insurance for Farmers, extension of the catalogue of services offered to farmers, including in the field of e-administration, and accident prevention.

For over 30 years, KRUS has carried out widespread preventive measures to reduce the number of occupational accidents and diseases among farmers. These efforts resulted in a reduction in the number of reported accidents in farms by more than 80%.

We pursue an ambitious goal of complete elimination of accidents and occupational diseases in agriculture in accordance with Vision Zero international prevention strategy, to which the Fund acceded in 2018.










Incidents reported as accidents in agriculture




Accidents in agriculture resulting in the payment of a one-off compensation for health damage or death


