• Resolution No 170 and No 173 – New M21

Reservations. The proposal concerning the new measure M21 and the related allocation of funds, are elaborated on the basis of the Commission proposal COM(2020) 186 of 30 April 2020 which is under discussion by the co-legislators and may be subject to amendments.

The Commission services are not allowed to approve a programme amendment in the absence of the relevant legal basis.
