Subject: Shuttle services

Dear Sirs.

Ministry of Transport and Communications presents its compliments to the Ministry of Infrastructure of the Republic of Poland.

As agreed at last Macedonian-Polish Joint Commission meeting on international road transport held in Skopje on 29-30 May 2012, the two countries exchange annual contingent of 50 shuttle service permits for transport of passengers. We have been informed by the border customs offices for frequent occurrence of Polish bus carriers transiting through the Republic of Macedonia that do not poss such permits. Our customs offices at the borders have been informed that Polish carriers when transiting through the Republic of Macedonia should hold shuttle service permits for transport of passengers in order to avoid delays in carrying out the transport operations.

So, we kindly ask you to inform Polish carriers that they should hold permits for shuttle services to smoothly pass in transit through the Republic of Macedonia Otherwise the customs authorities shall act in no other way but to prohibit them the entry into the Republic of Macedonia.

We are sure that our cooperation contributes to the achievement of common goals between our two countries.
