Conditions of importation of Fresh Fruits
(By Sea freight in Reefer Container Only)

From: Poland

1. Consignment should be free from the oriental fruit fly *Bactrocera dorsalis*, San José Scale *Diaspidiotus perniciosus*, *Rhagoletis sp*, the Mexican fruit flies *Anastrepha sp*, the fruit leaf folders *Proenlia sp*, the grape flat mite *Brevipalpus chilensis*.
2. In Transit Cold Sterilisation by **ONE** of the following cold treatment schedules:
 - (i) **0.0°C or below for 13 days**
 - (ii) **0.56°C or below for 14 days**
 - (iii) **1.11°C or below for 18 days**
 - (iv) **1.67°C or below for 20 days**
 - (v) **2.2°C or below for 22 days**
3. The fruits should originate from officially registered packing houses.
4. Printouts of all temperature sensors or direct electronic downloads are to be made available to the NPPO at the port of arrival in Mauritius for final clearance of the container.

**** In case of Re- Export, consignment of fruits should be accompanied by a certified true copy of the phytosanitary certificate issued by the country of origin certifying freedom from the specified diseases / pests.***
