# **GENERAL INFO**

Lufthansa German Airlines is planning another commercial special flight on Friday, June 5, 2020 at 01:55 AM in order to provide further travel possibilities within the given restrictions due to the ongoing Corona-crisis. Announcements about this flight will be shared via the respective embassies and business councils.

Lufthansa German Airlines is bookable for regular, scheduled flights to/from Riyadh as from mid-June 2020. This date however completely depends on lifting the air travel restrictions to/from Saudi Arabia. Based on the current situation in Saudi Arabia we expect a further delay of regular international air travel.

As much as Lufthansa wants to support in connecting people around the world with their beloved friends and relatives, we can only operate this flight once sufficient demand is given and all the regulatory approvals are granted.
