We support cities to tackle urban challenges!

- **Calls:**
- **DUT Call 2022 – 11 projects with Polish entities funded**
- **DUT Call 2023 – closed on 21.11.2023 (yesterday!); NCBR's budget: 1.82 M EUR**
- **DUT Call 2024 – planned 3rd quarter of 2024**

Thematic pathways:

- **Positive Energy Districts Pathway (PED)**
- **15-minute City Pathway (15minC)**
- **Circular Urban Economies Pathway (CUE)**

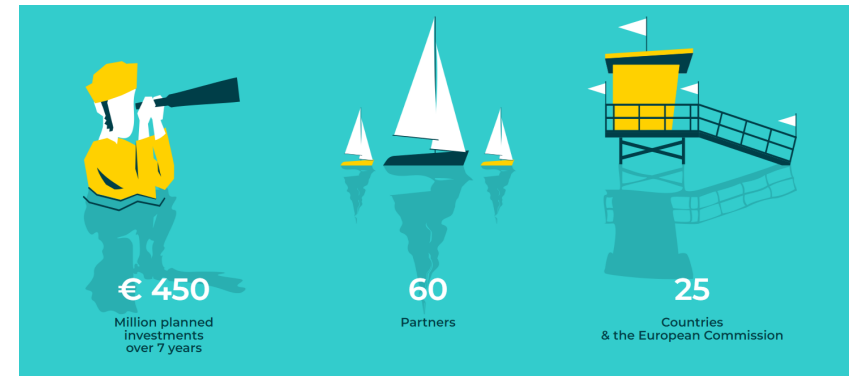
Facts

- A public-public partnership, co-funded by 28 European countries and the European Commission under Horizon Europe
- A consortium with 65+ national and regional R&I funders, authorities and agencies dealing with urban policy, research performing organisations and other organisations as strategic partners
- Annual calls addressing topics related to three impact pathways
- 450 million EURO minimum indicative budget for 2022-2028

The Sustainable Blue Economy Partnership (SBEP)



- **Calls:**
 - **SBEP Call 2023 – 12 projects with Polish entities got to the second stage; Funding: approx. 2.75 M EUR**
 - **SBEP Call 2023 – closes on 14.12.2023**
 - **SBEP Call 2024 – planned 1st quarter of 2024**

The Partnership boosts the transformation towards a climate-neutral, sustainable, productive and competitive blue economy. We aim to restore the ocean's health, resilience and services to people by enabling economic activity that is climate-neutral, sustainable and productive.

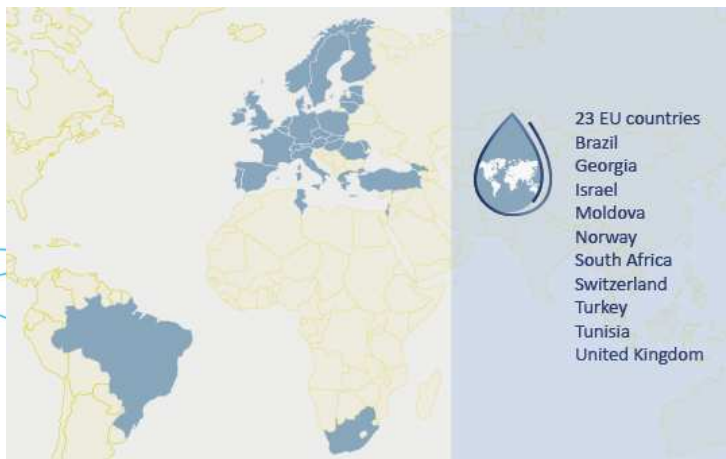
Water4All Partnership: Water Security for the planet

- **Calls:**

- **Water4All Call 2022 – 6 projects with Polish entities funded;**
- **Water4All Call 2023 – closed on 13.11.2023; NCBR's budget: 1 M EUR**
- **Water4All Call 2024 – planned 3rd quarter of 2024**



The Water4All Partnership - funding programme for scientific research in freshwater. It aims to tackle water challenges to face climate change, help to achieve the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals and boost the EU's competitiveness and growth. It is co-funded by the European Union within the frame of the Horizon Europe programme (a key funding programme for research and innovation). The Partnership duration is for seven years from 2022.



Clean Energy Transition Partnership (CETP)



- **Calls:**

- **CETP Joint Call 2022 – 4 projects with Polish entities funded;**
- **CETP Joint Call 2023 – closes on 22.11.2023 (!!); NCBR's budget: 3 M EUR**
- **CETP Joint Call 2024 – planned / 3rd quarter of 2024**



CETPartnership

The CETPartnership aims to empower the clean energy transition and contribute to the EU's goal of becoming the first climate-neutral continent by 2050, by pooling national and regional RDTI funding for a broad variety of technologies and system solutions required to make the transition. In that sense, the CETPartnership establishes the following 7 Transition Initiatives (TRIs), as the thematic configurations of CETPartnership funding partners in order to work together on:

- 1** Organising target group oriented stakeholder management and communication in the field
- 2** Developing thematic modules for the annual joint calls
- 3** Implementing accompanying activities on knowledge management and maximising impact

Innovative SMEs (Eurostars-3 Call 6)



- **Eligible institutions and/or partners: SMEs**



- **Eligible research types:**
 - industrial research,
 - development works



- **Budget: EUR 1,95 m (total allocation to be divided among succesful Polish applicants)**

- **Timeline: 12 January – 14 March 2024**

- **Thematic scope: no specific thematic focus**

CORNET (COLlective Research NETworking)

– Calls 37 and 38

Programme Aim: to develop and support collective research, with a particular focus on the role of SMEs

Call organiser: CORNET office in Germany (AiF – German Federation of Industrial Research Associations)

Eligible institutions and/or partners:

- SME associations (in cooperation with research organisations as research conductors)

Eligible research types:

- Industrial research and development work in accordance with the needs of a given sector
- Other – activities related to project results dissemination, promotion, project management, organising User Committee sessions

Budget:

- € 750k

Timeline:

- Call 37: 18 of January 2024
- Call 38: Q3/Q4 2024

INNOGLOBO programme



INNOGLOBO is an open international programme that complements the current offer of NCBR as part of the international cooperation.

Programme aim: enabling entities from Poland to establish R&D cooperation (in various areas) with foreign partners

Eligible institutions and/or partners:

- **research and knowledge-dissemination organizations**
- **micro, small, medium and large enterprises**
- **group of entities**

Eligible research types:

- **Industrial research**
- **Experimental development**

Budget:

- **PLN 15 m**
- **minimum amount of funding per project - PLN 400 k**
- **maximum amount of funding per project - PLN 1.5 m**

Timeline:

- **Call 4 - to be announced: 01.04.2024**
