- Through the **Digital Europe Programme**, the **European Commission has launched a collaborative effort to accelerate digital maturity**, with a particular focus on **cities and communities that are less digitally ready for digital transformation**. These services aim to foster the adoption of local digital twins and other digital solutions across rural and urban areas, ensuring that technology is accessible to all
- As part of the project, 150 European cities will complete three assessments, which will be used to develop customised roadmaps and procurement templates for each city towards the implementation of a Local Digital Twin

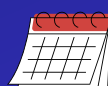
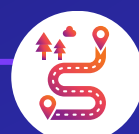
