

**JOINT MINISTERIAL STATEMENT BY POLAND AND SINGAPORE AFFIRMING COMMITMENT
TO STRENGTHEN ECONOMIC COOPERATION**

1. Poland and Singapore enjoy a longstanding and robust relationship based on shared interests and values. We recognize the potential to further expand our cooperation to foster economic growth as well as connectivity.
2. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, we reaffirm our commitment to strengthening bilateral cooperation to the benefit of our people and businesses. We will work closely to identify and make use of trade opportunities to connect supply chains and improve and expedite the flow of goods, in particular essential goods, including food and agricultural products.
3. We recognize that it is in our mutual interest to ensure continued strong connectivity between our economies. We will coordinate our efforts to ensure that trade lines, including via air and sea freight, are open, efficient and effective in facilitating the flow of goods, making our economies stronger and more resilient.
4. The cooperation mentioned in this Statement is consistent with the rights and obligations of the Republic of Poland arising from its membership in the European Union.
