### NOTICE TO SKIPPERS No 10/2024

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of July 20, 2017 - Water Law (consolidated text Dz.U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2023, item 1478 as amended) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of December 21, 2000 on inland navigation (consolidated text Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2022, item 1097) National Water Management Holding "Wody Polskie" Regional Water Management Board in Cracow, informs that on March 16, 2024 on the section of the Vistula River from km 87+000 to km 88+500 (Yacht Klub Polski Cracow) there will be an event on the water called "Krakowski Spływ Morsów" (based on the permission of the Director of the Delegation in Cracow of the Inland Navigation Office in Wrocław, reference number: NZKR.602.2.2024.RS of February 23, 2024). **The navigable route on the Vistula River will be partially closed on March 16, 2024 at 11:00 – 13:00 on the section of the Vistula River from km 87+000 to km 88+500** along the left bank at a distance of no more than 50 m from this bank, so that the trail is clear navigable remained on the right bank.
