

**ORDINANCE
OF THE PRIME MINISTER**

of 23 April 2009

**on the types of documents confirming the command of the Polish language by non-Polish
citizens applying for a position in the civil service**

(Journal of Laws of 28 April 2009)

Pursuant to art. 5 par. 3 of the Act of 21 November 2008 on Civil Service (Journal of Laws No. 227, item 1505) it is hereby ordered as follows:

§ 1 Documents confirming the command of the Polish language by non-Polish citizens, applying for position in the civil service are:

- 1) A certificate confirming the command of the Polish language by passing the Polish language exam at B2 intermediate or B1 advanced level, issued by the State Commission for the Certification of Proficiency in Polish as a Foreign Language;
- 2) Documents confirming the graduation of university studies conducted in the Polish language;
- 3) Matriculation certificate obtained in the Polish educational system;
- 4) Certificate to practice as a certified translator issued by the Minister of Justice.

§ 2 This Regulation shall enter into force on the date of publication.
