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<b>Funding commitment</b>	2 500 000 EUR
<b>Anticipated number of fundable proposals</b>	1-5
<b>Maximum/ Minimum funding per grant awarded to a clinical study partner</b>	Maximum 500 000 €
<b>Funding mechanism</b>	Only one organisation will be granted and this organisation will establish a collaboration with other recruitment sites via subcontracting or a collaboration agreement.
<b>Eligibility of partners</b>	Following entities are eligible to apply:  <b>Research organization</b> (research and knowledge-dissemination organisations) <sup>1</sup> .  Entities must be established as a legal person <sup>2</sup> and must conduct its business, R&D or any other activity on the territory of the Republic of Poland, confirmed by an entry into the relevant register <sup>3</sup> .
<b>Eligibility of costs, types and their caps</b>	The eligible costs shall be the following: 1. personnel costs 2. consumables 3. equipment 4. travel 5. other direct costs 6. subcontracting - this cost type cannot account for more than 70% of all eligible costs of a project 7. additional overheads incurred indirectly as a result of the research project; that costs are exactly 25% of eligible project costs and are counted

<b>Submission of other information at the national level</b>	After international evaluation of full proposals and the selection of projects to be funded, Polish participants will be invited to submit a National Application Form (NAF). The NAFs will be examined for the appropriateness of funding requested. The Polish participants are obliged to use the rate of exchange of the European Central Bank dated on the day of opening of the call.
