Statue to 2nd International Piano Duets Contest Zambrów 2024

- 1. The Organizer to the competition is Witold Lutoslawski's State Music School of First degree in Zambrów.
- 2. Honorary patronage:
 - Head of Zambrów County Office,
 - Mayor of Zambrów,
 - Head of Zambrów Borough.
- 3. The contess is to be held every 2 years.
- 4. 2nd edition to the contest is going to be held on November 22nd in Witold Lutoslawski's State Music School of First degree in Zambrów.
- 5. Auditions are going to be held both on-scene and online.
- 6. The contest's objectives:
 - popularization of piano salon music,
 - creating potential for students' rivarly in fields like presentation and encounter in a friendly and kind atmosphere,
 - choosing and promoting the best young piano players,
 - elevating drum teaching skills via experience and literture exchange as well as repertoire materials broadening,
 - eqalizing teaching levels,
 - teaching experience exchange,
- 7. Competition's auditions are going to be held in four group cathegories:

Group I – I^{st} grade music school students classes I^{st} – IV^{th} of six years and eaight years learning cycle and classes I^{st} – II^{nd} of four year learning cycle, born in 2013 and younger

Group II – I^{st} grade music school students classes V^{th} – VI^{th} of six years and eaight years learning cycle and classes III^{rd} – IV^{st} of four year learning cycle, born in 2011 and younger

Group III – I^{st} grade public music school students classes VII^{th} – $VIII^{th}$ and II^{nd} grade music school students classes I^{st} – II^{nd} , born in 2009 and younger

Group IV – II^{nd} grade music school students classes III^{rd} – VI^{th} and II^{nd} grade public music school students classes I^{st} – IV^{th} born after 2008.

In a case of students of one group representing two different age groups, they are to be qualified to a group of an the older contenstant.

Foreign contestants are qualified to individual groups based on their age.

This criterium does not apply to polish contestants.

8. Contest's Programme

Group I – I^{st} grade music school students classes I^{st} – IV^{th} of six years and eaight years learning cycle and classes I^{st} – II^{nd} of four year learning cycle, born in 2013 and younger

Two music pieces of contrasting style, in which, minimum one piece of polish-originated composer or a composer of contestants' country of origin (a piece played by four hands or two grand pianos to be decided by contestants)

It is allowed to perform sheet music playing. Self arrangement presentation possibile. Time of performance up to 10 minutes.

Group II – I^{st} grade music school students classes V^{th} – VI^{th} of six years and eaight years learning cycle and classes III^{rd} – IV^{st} of four year learning cycle, born in 2011 and younger

- 1. Obligatory piece: minimum one piece of Ignacy Jan Paderewski collection Tatrzanskie Albums
- 2. Freeform polish composer piece or any piece of contestants' country of origin of contestant.

It is allowed to perform sheet music playing. Self arrangement presentation possibile. Time of performance up to 15 minutes.

Group III – I^{st} grade public music school students classes VII^{th} – $VIII^{th}$ and II^{nd} grade music school students classes I^{st} – II^{nd} , born in 2009 and younger

- 1. Obligatory piece: J.Garścia Little Partitia op. 18 (2 parts minimum)
- 2. Two music pieces of contrasting style, in which, minimum one piece of polish-originated composer or a composer of contestants' country of origin (a piece played by four hands or two grand pianos to be decided by contestants)

It is allowed to perform sheet music playing, one piece minimum should be composed originally for piano duets. Time of performance up to 20 minutes.

Group IV – II^{nd} grade music school students classes III^{rd} – VI^{th} and II^{nd} grade public music school students classes I^{st} – IV^{th} born after 2008.

- 1. Obligatory piece: Selectable: W. A. Mozart Ist 4 hands sonata (played by four hands or two grand pianos) or C. Debussy Petite Suite played by four hands (2 parts minimum)
- 2. Obligatory piece: Variations by Paganini played on 2 Witold Lutoslawski's grands pianos
- 3. Freeform polish composer piece or any piece of contestants' country of origin of contestant.

It is allowed to perform sheet music playing. Time of performance up to 30 minutes.

9. Contest's auditions are to be held in one stage for all groups with the audience presence both on-scene and online.

10. Tapes are going to be marked by the Jury while the contest is going to be held. They will be screened on a high quality audiovisuals in the Organizer's Contert Hall.

11. Tapes specifications:

- a musician's silhouette must be visible during the whole recording (musical instruments itself in particular),
- recording must be performed in one take, no editing,
- horizontal perspective in a must,
- recording needs to be upoloaded solely on a private YouTube channel, in a non-public format,
- direct link to a recording must be placed in an apllication form,
- in a recordning's description please place: FIRST AND LAST NAME OF THE COMPOSER AND THE MUSIC PIECE TITLE
- 12. Orfer of music pieces performance is free.
- 13. Any participation by musicians prepared by the Jury is forbidden.
- 14. Performance assessment.

Contestants, in terms of technical and artistic performance are going to be assessed by the following Jury:

- prof. dr hab. Joanna Ławrynowicz-Just Frederic Chopin Music University in Warsaw Chairman,
- prof. dr hab. Katarzyna Makal- Żmuda Frederic Chopin Music University in Warsaw, Białystok Branch,
- prof. dr hab. Robert Morawski Frederic Chopin Music University in Warsaw,
- Adam Januszkiewicz MA PSM I st. Zambrów Secretary.

The Jury is going to assess in 1 to 25 point scale, individually by each. Jury's Secretary figures the score, which is the result of arithmetic mean.

Criteria for The Prize winners stand as follows:

- 25 points Grand Prix
- 23 24 points Ist place,
- 22 points IInd place,
- 21 points IIIrd place,
- 19 20 points Honour.

Jury's decisions are made based on recorded vote scoring system.

In the case of disagreement the Chairman of the Jury has the casting vote.

Jury's decisions are final and indesputable

- 15. Jury assesses each separately in every contest's stage (both on-scene and online).
- 16. Jury awards special prizes, besides main prizes and honours in each group (for instance for polish composer music piece perofmance)

- 17. Each contestant receives a participation Diploma.
- 18. Results announcement and the award ceremony are going to be held during the Laureates' concert.
- 19. Laureates' participation in Laureates' concert is obligatory.

- 21. The Organizer does not cover any transportation, accommodation or catering costs of the contestants.
- 22. Contest's auditions schedule as well as rehearsals schedule as going to be published on a Organizers' website after the list of participants in finalized. In case of a large number of registration, acoustic rehearsals may be held the day before the contest's auditions.
- 23. According to art. 81 section 1 of copyright law related rights, a legal guardian of each contestant (contestant if he or she is an adult the day of application) gives consent to Witold Lutoslawski's State Music School of First degree in Zambrów unlimited in time and free or charge power to publish the contestans' public image.
