Pursuant to Article 131 paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, you are hereby notified by the Public Prosecutor's Office in Warsaw having its office at ul. Chocimska 28 that:

On 10 February 2022, following the conclusion that the act in question does not have the qualities of a prohibited act, a decision was made to discontinue the investigation number 3041-1.Ds.32.2022 relating to causing a direct danger of an aviation accident on 1 November 2011 as a result of damaging the hydraulic, electrical and mechanical system of the landing gear extension, which led to an emergency landing of the Boeing 767 Number SP-LPC at the Chopin airport in Warsaw, i.e. the offence defined in Article 174 paragraph 1 of the Criminal Code on the basis of Article 174 paragraph 1 subparagraph 1 of the Criminal Code - on the basis of Article 17 paragraph 1 subparagraph 2 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The parties aggrieved by the offence may, within 7 days of pronouncement of the decision, file an application to have a certified copy of the decision to discontinue proceedings served on them. The time limit is strict and final. The aggrieved parties have to right to access the case file and make an interlocutory appeal against the decision to the court having jurisdiction to hear the case.

The interlocutory appeal shall be filed via the public prosecutor who issued the decision, within a strict and final time limit of 7 days of receipt of a certified copy of the decision. The time limit is strict and final.

An interlocutory appeal filed after the expiry of the prescribed time limit shall have no effect.
