**Phytosanitary requirements for importation of Barley grain (*Hordeum vulgare*) for human edible livestock feeding to Iran**

- 1- **Issuance a valid phytosanitary certificate** from the country of origin in whose Additional Declarations (A.D) section following item is confirmed:
  - a. **Grains are free from the following pest and diseases:**
    - 1- *Araecerus fasciculatus*
    - 2- *Mayrtiola destructor*
    - 3- *Anguina agrostis*
    - 4- *Trogoderma spp.*

**Note:**

**Mentioning the scientific name of above diseases in the phytosanitary certificate of above consignment is mandatory; otherwise, customs clearance will be prevented due to insufficient documentation, any and all damages and losses being on importers account.**

- 2- The consignment must be free of dust, live insects and weed seeds.
- 3- Delivering the original phytosanitary certificate with mentioned requirements, as well as other necessary documents to quarantine experts at the time of investigating the consignment in destination border and customs clearance is mandatory. Otherwise, the importer will be found responsible for the consequences.
- 4- Transferring the consignment to domestic customs is only allowed after surveying and approving the original necessary documentation in the entrance customs.
- 5- If the consignment is exported via a third country, a copy of phytosanitary certificate of the first exporter country (with all mentioned requirements) stamped by the second exporter country officials accompanied by the original Re-exporter phytosanitary certificate must be presented to quarantine officials at the point of entry and to the customs clearance office.
