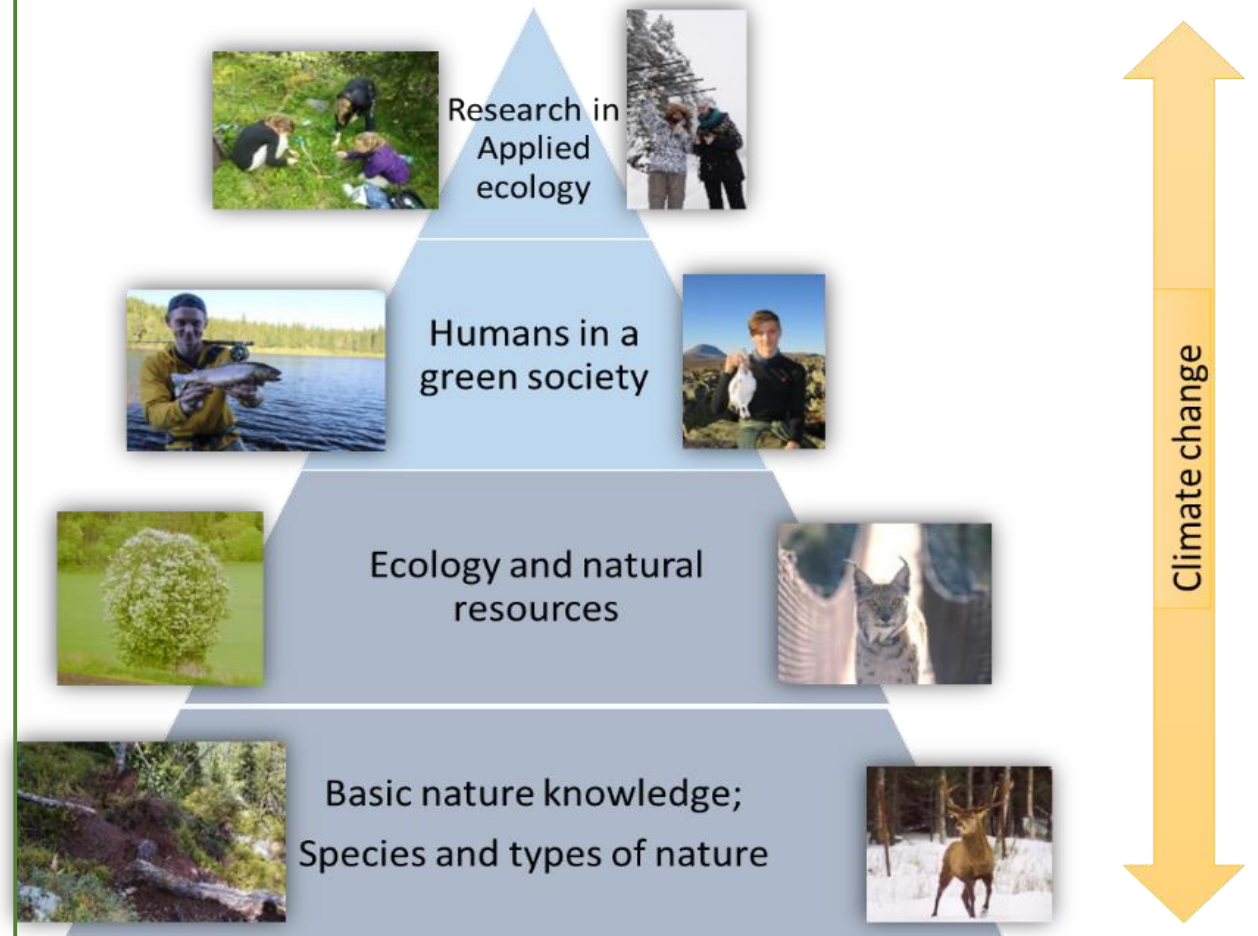

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Profile; the first highschool in Norway specialized on climate change and biodiversity

- **Age 15 – 19**
- **Pedagogic profile:**
 - 5 – 6 weeks interdisciplinary blocks
 - **climate change** and biodiversity loss
 - **fieldwork** out **in the nature** or field trip to nature based business
 - develop **practical and theoretical skills** related to **climate change in different point of views**





The Norwegian Nature and Ecology Highschool (NNE)

- Climate change are mandatory subjects
- Can be developed to schools in Scandinavia and Europe
- Develop new curricula and teaching methods to acquire the necessary knowledge and competences for climate change education



Mission ideas for the collaboration

- *Climate change will be widely communicated and discussed in the public spheres; NNE invites common people and younger children to climate change events*
- *The concept of the school can be developed into new regions*
- Arrange a youth conference of Climate change at NNE
 - Norwegian and Polish youth can stay together for one week
 - International climate change researchers give talks
 - Fieldwork and workshops
 - Final presentation by the youth of what they have done this week
