Between 2022 and 2023, as many as **81.1%** of those taking the GCSE in Polish were awarded a grade of 7 or above.



In 2023, more than **7,000** pupils passed the GCSE in Polish.



The exams take place in the summer session each year

The time needed to prepare for the exams may vary and depends on your skills; it usually takes between one to two years to reach the proficiency level required for the Polish language GCSE exam.
