Agriculture quarantine requirements on importing of timber from abroad.

- 1- Imported timber must be free of any pests or disease, or any harmful organisms through any phase of development does not show any trace of such effect.
- 2- Imported timber must be free of any bark (peel).
- 3- Related Agriculture Health Certificate issued by relevant authority from the exporting country proving its testing and that the shipment is free from any pests or any plant disease or any part of bark (peel).
  If chemically treated it must be mentioned in the certificate mentioning the kind, dose, and the date of the treatment.
- 4- In case of breach of any of the mentioned conditions the supplier is committed to comply to the decision of the inspector of the Control Centre for Food and Medicine related to the imported shipment. Implement and execute shipment refusal, reexport procedure, chemical treatment, or supervised destruction by the inspectors from the mentioned centre.
