## GENERAL GUIDANCE ON RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS FOR UK NATIONALS

### THE UK NATIONALS SUPPORT FUND (UKNSF) IN POLAND

IOM is providing additional support to UK Nationals who may find it harder to complete their residency application to secure and maintain their residency rights in Poland now that the United Kingdom has left the EU.

Through the UK Nationals Support Fund (UKNSF), IOM seeks to assist those living in Poland in settling their residence status by offering various forms of support. To support all those who may need assistance, the project will be active until March 2021 and is conducted in close coordination with the British Embassy in Warsaw.

### SUPPORT OPTIONS

IOM Warsaw offers you the following kinds of support:

- Awareness raising among UK nationals living in Poland
- Provision of information in English and Polish via phone and mail
- Provision of accessible information on residency requirements
- Practical support in completing applications
