- 5 EU Missions – several activities launched
- TRAMI stands for **TRAnsnational cooperation on the Missions approach.**
- **TRAMI, the cross-cutting project helping the implementation of the Missions approach**
- Duration: 04/2022 – 04/2024
- **26 partners from 17 MS and AS**, mostly administrations and agencies tasked with the implementation of missions with the ambition of creating sustainable structures and processes to support the governance of mission implementation.

Objectives

To support the **alignment and coordination** between national, regional and local initiatives

To **exchange best practice** on how national, regional and local efforts and related funding can contribute to missions' objectives

To **facilitate the engagement of regional and local actors** in support of EU-level and national activities;

To **map the relevant national, regional and local stakeholders** (incl. civil society organisations and institutions) and **funding streams**

To **prepare for potential hubs at national level**

To **develop the basis for a mission governance model**

To **raise awareness and to engage and mobilise key stakeholders and citizens** to actively participate in EU Missions processes and activities

To build and consolidate a sustainable European Mission Core Network

To provide policy intelligence related to the missions

To promote knowledge exchange, mutual learning and dissemination and engagement of stakeholders

To engage and mobilise key stakeholders and citizens

...across the missions and governance levels
...with a view to build sustainable 'infrastructures'

- Intended to be sustained and link to EU decision making processes

MAPPING

- Setup of a **data base** to monitor the implementation of the missions

MLE

- **Mutual Learning Events + Use Cases**
- Flexible, varying topics, user oriented / driven

- **European Mission Forum**
- Addressing broader stakeholder groups



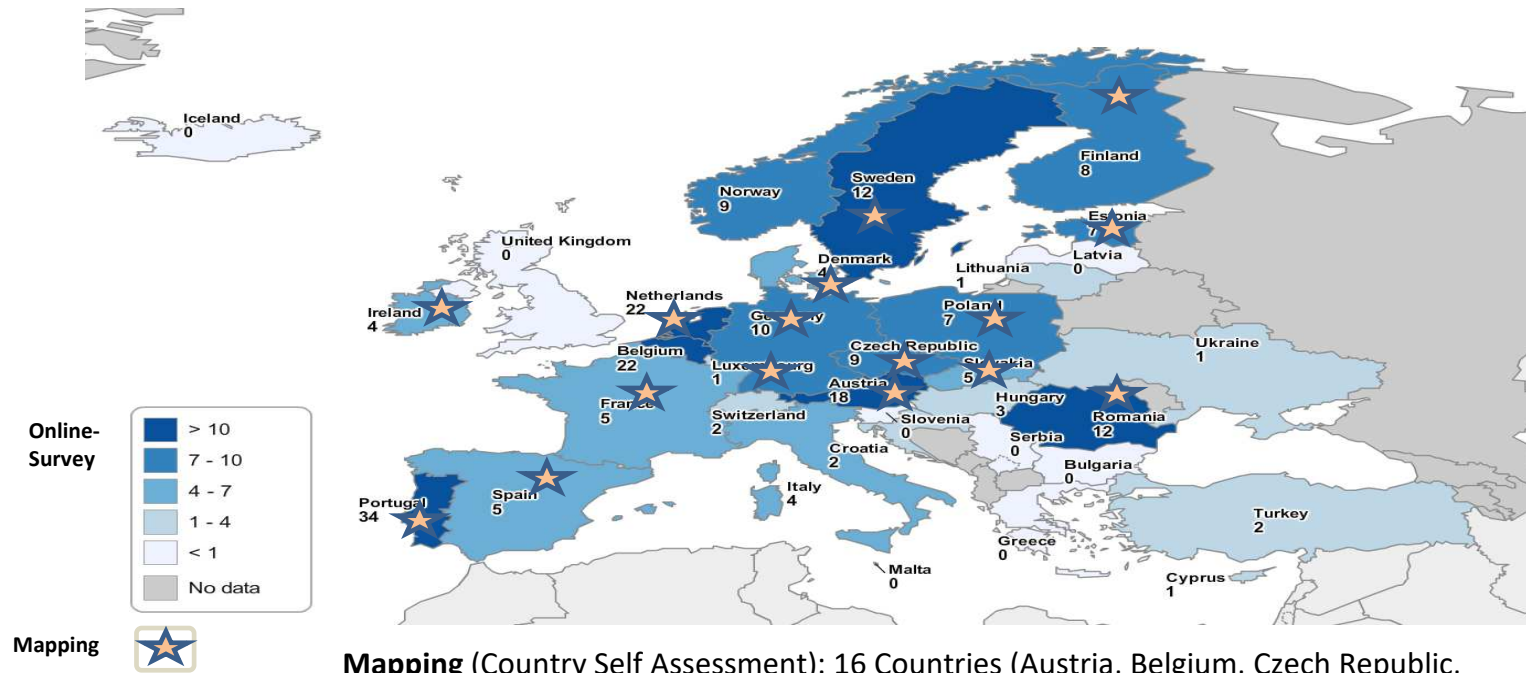

- Mapping mission oriented policy initiatives and actors
- Building up a database on the EU missions and their structures at regional and national level

The Mission Data Platform is an online database and a dynamic repository that gathers, curates, and disseminates a broad spectrum of knowledge pertinent to mission-oriented policies in the context of the EU Missions. By showcasing gathered data on the development of mission governance structure, actor constellations and instrument portfolios across EU Member States and Associated Countries, it facilitates the exchange of information, fosters cooperation among stakeholders and supports the successful implementation of EU missions and mission-oriented policies. The mission data platform has been developed within TRAMI (Transnational cooperation on the Missions approach), an EU funded project focusing on Making Missions Work by creating Communities of Practice, exchanging knowledge and offering mutual learning.
