

Game Jam is a 24-48 hour marathon that takes place on 6-8 November in a mixed form: online/ stationary. Participants will compete to create the most unique and entertaining game in several categories - one of them could be pointed out by

the IGF Secretariat.

We expect over 1.000 international participants, mostly students & journalists. All age categories and professions are much welcome to join.



HackYeah



27 – 29 November 2020

Hack Yeah takes place on 27-29 November, this year fully online due to the COVID-19 restrictions. We do take care of your security and safety, but still want to connect you with other brightest minds from all over the world!

We expect at least 8.000 participants - mostly young & talented programmers, joining the hackathon globally. One of the categories is chosen by the IGF Secretariat and the IGF Community.

We will also broadcast live HackYeah TV, where you can watch:
HackYeah News, interviews with partners and attendees,
numerous webinars, YouTubers performances or hacking great movies.

HackYeah is more than a hackathon - it's basically a huge IT festival!
