Professor habilitated doctor Cezary Szyfman – baritone started his music education at The2nd Level State Music school in Białystok, under the guidance of M. Bieniecka. He is a graduate of the Vocal Art and Acting of Frederic Chopin Music Academy in Warsaw, where his academic tutors were Michał Szopski and Professor Kazimierz Pustelak. In the academic year 2002/2003 he worked as a visiting professor at F. Chopin Keimyung Academy of Music in Daegu (The Republic of Korea). At present, he is a professor at two artistic higher schools: Frederic Chopin Music University in Warsaw and Aleksander Zelwerowicz Theatre Academy in Warsaw. In 2014, he achieved the title of Professor of musical arts. Apart from numerous chamber music concerts, oratorios and theatre performances, Cezary Szyfman took part in the most important festivals, in Poland and abroad (such as Scottish Early Music Festival, Holland Festival, Schlezwig-Holstein Musik Festival, Festival Stichting Pratum Musicum Utrecht,, Glasgow International Early Music Festival). He also took part in concerts in numerous countries of Europe, Asia, Africa and the United States of America, Cezary Szyfman is deeply interested in various forms of theatre, which can be exemplified by his co-operation with a few theatres in the country (The Grotesque in Cracow, The Footlights in Warsaw, The "Baj" in Toruń, The Gulliver in Warsaw, The Białystok Puppet Theatre, The Seaside Theatre in Gdańsk). Professor Szyfman participated in realizing performances by being in charge of both vocal and instrumental elements. As for Cezary Szyfman's pedagogical activity, he lays great emphasis on shaping attitudes and abilities of the youngest generation. Since 1995, as an experienced performer of historical music, the artist has been systematically conducting numerous workshops for ensembles of old - time chamber music. For over a dozen vears he has also been on the jury of the annual All- Polish Review of Old - Time Chamber Music "Schola Cantorum" in Kalisz. Moreover, Professor Szyfman has often been invited to give lectures and conduct seminars devoted to widely understood work on the voice, both in the domain of speech and of singing. Several times has the singer been rewarded and awarded for his activity. He received the 1st and the 2nd Level Rector's Award, the Medal of the National Education Commission, the Badge of Honour: "Meritorious for the Polish Culture" and the Silver Cross of Merit. Together with the "Il CANTO DA CAMERA" ensemble, he is also a laureate of significant prizes in the domain of vocal chamber music, won at prestigious international competitions, and what is more, he is a co-laureate of three Frederics in the domain of old-time music. The prize is awarded by The Phonographic Academy for the most eminent phonographic achievements in Poland in a given year. Professor Szyfman is Head of the Department of Vocal Pedagogics of Frederic Chopin Music University. He is: a) a co-organizer of:

- vocal competitions conducted by outstanding national and international vocal artists
- a number of operatic performances realized by students of the Vocal Division of the Białystok Branch.
- b) head of a few editions of the All-Polish Educational and Didactic Conference "The Challenges of Modern Vocal Pedagogics" https://www.radio.bialystok.pl/reportaz/index/id/129843

Paweł Chomczyk — an actor, director and puppeteer is a graduate of A. Zelwerowicz Theatre Academy in Warsaw, Puppetry Art Department in Białystok and of the Department of Education and Psychology of Białystok University. He also studied at the Department of Theatre and Dance of The New York State University in Buffalo (USA). He is a habilitated doctor in the domain of Theatrical Arts. The performances realized with the participation of Paweł Chomczyk and coproduced by him, as part of the activities of independent theatres co-created by him (Doomsday Company and Coincidentia Group) were presented at theatre festivals and on impresario stages in many countries of Europe, North America and Asia. As an actor, Mr Chomczyk co-operated with numerous institutional theatres, e.g. in Łódź, Białystok, Warsaw, Kielce and Toruń, whereas, as an academic teacher - with the Department of Theatre and Dance of The New York State University in Buffalo and with the Puppetry Art Department of the Theatre Academy. As a member of the international Krabat Ensemble, Paweł Chomczyk carries out permanent co-operation with the following German theatres: Lindenfels Westfluegel Leipzig i Figurentheater Wilde&Vogel. Apart from theatre productions, Mr Chomczyk's achievements include parts acted on the radio, on TV and in films.

MAIN ACHIEVEMENTS - Paweł Chomczyk is a laureate of more than a dozen individual actor prizes and awards (among others, Grand Prix of Paderewski Festival in Buffalo/USA/, Grand Prix of the 4thInternational Festival Kon – Texts/ in Poznań, Silver Thumb 2019 – the prize of Białystok journalists) and several dozen awards and prizes awarded to performances he co-created as a producer and/or actor (among others, The Bank of Scotland Herald Angel, Total Theatre Award at the Fringe Festival in Edinburgh , Grand Prix of the 24th International Festival "Spotkania" /Meetings/ in Toruń). Within the previous decade, the performances of the Coincidentia Group, whose artistic leader is Mr Chomczyk, were included in more than a hundred festivals and on over sixty impresario stages in Poland, Germany, Slovakia, Ukraine, Austria, Switzerland, France, The Netherlands, Belgium, Italy, Denmark, Great Britain and Japan. It was three times that The Coincidentia Group was situated in the forefront, two of these times taking the 1st place, among Polish theatres most frequently going abroad, according to the annual report of Z. Raszewski Theatre Institute. Four times were The Coincidentia performances situated in the final of the Theatre-Poland programme of the Warsaw Theatre Institute. In the evaluation of the Teatr magazine (the best – they, she, he), the performances of the Group were awarded more than a dozen times.

AT FREDERIC CHOPIN MUSIC UNIVERSITY, Paweł Chomczyk is a member of the Department Commission for Ensuring the Quality of Education at the Department of Instrumental Music and Pedagogics, Music Education and Vocal Art; Secretary of the Vocal Education Division. Paweł Chomczyk – the winner of Actor's Prize of the title part in the performance entitled "Don Quixote" (realized in co-production of the Białystok Coincidentia Group and Pinocchio Theatre from Łódź). Paweł Chomczyk, a Białystok actor, lecturer and social work volunteer, is the first laureate of the new Białystok prize, the Silver Thumb. The prize is given by the award jury consisting of Białystok journalists observing theatre life in the city.
