DESCRIPTION (field, expectations, comments):

I. Performing works for the Rescue Operation Department including in particular:

- Supporting, participation in research activities
- Providing lectures and leading laboratory works for full-time and extramural students in Polish
- Supervising Eng. and M.Eng. diploma theses
- Participation in national and international scientific projects, involvement in finding funding opportunities
- Involvement in conferences and seminar organization, cooperation with external entities, realization of external orders
- Participation in different activities (realization of tasks within commissions, work groups).

II. Requirements to be met by the candidate:

- PhD in the field of technical sciences as environmental eng.
- Scientific output would be a benefit
- Flexibility, interest in safety-related issues, including fire safety and environmental pollution monitoring
- Intention to self-develop

III. Skills:

- Fluent communication skills in English (at least C1).
- Operation of specialized environments, e.g. MatLAB.

IV. Required documents:

- Employment application;
- Curriculum vitae including educational and scientific experience (if concerns) together with publication list;
- Personal questionnaire including declaration that You are acquainted with the clause contained in the announcement about the competition;

- Declaration that the candidate comply with the regulation according to the art. 109 paragraph 1 point 2-5 enactment of 27 July 2005 Law on higher education (Dz. U. z 2016 r. poz. 1842);
- Declaration about acceptance of being able to be employed on the first place as an educational and scientific employee in the Main School of Fire according to the Law on higher educational (Dz. U. z 2016 r. poz. 1842);
- Consent for processing of personal data that were provided voluntarily by the person applying for employment for the purpose of recruitment process (e.g. different data than specified in art. 22 paragraph 1 Labor code).

The settlement of the competition does not result in the establishment of an employment relationship.

Employment decision will be made by Rector-Commandant of The Main School of Fire Service.

The Main School of Fire Service reserves the right to close the competition without settlement.

Information

According to the art. 13 paragraph 1 and 2 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Text with EEA relevance) (Dz.U.U.E.L.2016.119.1), called further "RODO", we would like to inform that:

3. Your personal data will be processed in order to comply the recreation process at the Main School of Fire Service according to the art. 6 paragraph 1 letter c of "RODO" and according to the art. 22¹ § 1 of Labor Code and, art. 6 paragraph 1 letter a of "RODO".
4. The recipients of Your personal data – there are none.
5. Your personal data shall not be transferred to a third country or an international organization.
6. Your personal data will be stored until after the recruiting process.
7. You have the rights to access your personal data, to rectify the data, to erasure or restrict of your personal data processing and the right to Your personal data portability.
8. Concerning Your personal data processing You have the right to withhold the authorization for Your personal data processing at any time without any effect on compliance with the law of the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority – the President of the Office of Personal Data Protection, if you feel that Your personal data processing violate "RODO" regulations.
