Notice to Skippers no. 20/2024

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of July 20, 2017 - Water Law (consolidated text Dz.U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2023, item 1478 as amended) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of December 21, 2000 on inland navigation (consolidated text Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2022, item 1097) National Water Management Holding "Wody Polskie" Regional Water Management Board in Cracow, informs that in connection with the planned research geophysical surveys of the bottom of the Vistula River on June 11 and 13, 2024 by the GEOTECH Geological Services Department Sp. z o. o. under contract No. 433/RUM/2024/NN/KRU2, **the navigable route on the Vistula River on June 11 and 13, 2024 at 11:00 - 15:00 will be closed to shipping traffic on the section from km 73+000 to km 74+000.** Only vessels can enter the area excluded from navigation taking part in the works and securing them, as well as ships of the operator of the Krakow Water Tram.
