



Memorandum of Understanding

concluded on 17th September, 2024

between:

Office of the Historian of the City of Havana with address at Calle Amargura no. 65 e/ Mercaderes y San Ignacio, La Habana Vieja, Havana, Cuba hereinafter referred to as 'OHCH'

and

Copernicus Science Centre
with registered office in Warsaw
Wybrzeże Kościuszkowskie 20
hereinafter referred to as "CSC"

1. The purpose of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to promote cooperation and exchange programs in science education based on the following activities (hereinafter referred to as "Activities"):

- 1) familiarizing the Partner with the Young Explorers Clubs Program (YEC)
- 2) identifying the conditions for creating the an on-site exhibition
- 3) sharing the best practices in the scope of science education
- 4) exchange information about educational programs and other educational activities.

In order to promote/create a network of Young Explorers Clubs gathering teachers and students around Cuba as a part of a partnership with the Copernicus Science Centre, Office of the Historian of the City of Havana, will:

- organize YEC initial workshop for the teachers and educators interested in joining the YEC program
- provide with a room space for workshops
- organize basic materials for experiments
- indicate future coordinators of the YEC in Cuban (they should communicate in English)
- diagnose the potential of program development in the country

Copernicus Science Centre will:

- share the ideas, goals and development model of the YEC based on the YEC Card

- share the ideas, goals and development model of the on-site exhibition
- Provide consultancy for the Office of the Historian of the City of Havana on the creation of an AIDA on-site exhibition,
- provide with trainings for the YEC Educators and facilitators
- share YEC by emails in English

3. In order to implement and develop the above YEC, Parties shall agree to have discussions to establish common goals, directions of actions and detailed commitments of the Parties of the MoU.

4. MoU will not result in financial liabilities.

5. MoU is concluded for an indefinite period. either party may terminate by giving one month's notice, in writing.

6 Specific roles, terms and conditions in carrying out of Activities and cooperation shall, in a spirit of reciprocity, be negotiated separately and shall be made into a written agreement taking into consideration the laws and regulations related thereto of respective state.

7. If there is any dispute or doubt regarding the interpretation of any article hereof, Parties shall amicably and immediately confer in good faith to resolve the issue. This MoU shall be made in duplicate and each party shall have one original copy.
