

**‘My Poland 2020’  
Art Competition for Children  
Rules and Regulations**

1. The aim of this competition is to promote knowledge of Poland, its history, culture and heritage, and primarily to promote the Polish contribution in the cultural, economic and social life of Great Britain. This competition is part of the 4<sup>th</sup> of the Polish Heritage Days and aims to stress the positive impact of one million Poles in the United Kingdom.
2. The organiser of this competition is the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in London at 47 Portland Place W1B 1JH London.
3. This competition is open to all children up to eighteen years of age, who currently reside in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
4. This competition involves the conception and preparation of any creative and artistic work which refers to the heritage of Polish history, culture and patriotic values as transmitted from one generation to another.
5. This work should be submitted as a digital photograph in .jpg or .png format up to 26 April 2020 to the following email address: [london.events@msz.gov.pl](mailto:london.events@msz.gov.pl). The work should include the following information:
  - a. The name and author of the artwork,
  - b. the town or city of residence of the author of the artwork,
  - c. the name and author of the legal guardian of the author of the artwork,
  - d. a description of the artwork,
  - e. an email address to which the results of the competition will be submitted, and
  - f. a document giving to consent to the use of personal data for the purpose of the competition.
6. Once the artwork is submitted to the organisers of this competition, the organisers then acquires the right to use this artwork for the following purposes:
  - a. The archival of the artwork, and the recording and publishing of the artwork in any digital format, in any form of multimedia networks, in both internal and external platforms of the organisers;
  - b. The publishing of this artwork, so that anyone can have free access to it, this includes publishing of this artwork on the websites and social media platforms of the organisers, and in any other related websites;
  - c. The use of this work (or any of its fragments) for informational and educational purposes but also for scientific uses in keeping with the mission of the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in London;

7. The results of this competition will be announced on 02 May 2020 by the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in London on the Day of Poles and Polish Diaspora Abroad and the Day of the Flag of the Republic of Poland through the Embassy's social media platforms.
8. The winners of the first three places in each of the categories will be awarded the titled of laureate and will receive a prize funded by the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in London in the form of educational materials, while the legal guardians of the winners will also receive book prizes.
9. The organisers also reserve the right to grant any additional prizes to authors whose works deserve distinction for its artistic and historical value.
10. All participants shall receive a diploma of participation in the aforementioned competition.
