Dear colleague.-

Very respectfully I am writing to you, in order to inform you that after carrying out the Phytosanitary Technical Review for the item: grains of wheat *Triticum aestivum* L., from the Republic of Poland, the following phytosanitary requirements were established:

- The Phytosanitary Certificate of origin must indicate that the product is free of the fungus: *Tilletia controversa* J. G. Kühn and *Tilletia tritici* (Bjerk.) G. (supported by laboratory analysis) and the weeds: Aspera spica-venti, *Cirsium arvense* (L.) Scop. 1772, *Elymus repens* L. Gould 1947 and *Polygonum convolvulus* L
- -Pre-shipment treatment with: Phosphine: 3 to 4 gr per m3 at a temperature of 21°C or more, for 72 hours. The plant health inspector will verify that this treatment has been completed before the arrival of the product in the country.

In addition, the other basic technical notes established for these products must be added.

With nothing more to add for the time being, I make the occasion to reiterate my feelings of consideration and esteem.
