

Updated Country/Region Classification and Border Measures for Inbound Travellers



From 9 September, 2359 hours:

- All inbound travellers entering or transiting through Singapore from Category II, III and IV countries/regions will need to produce a negative pre-departure COVID-19 PCR test result taken within 48 hours before departure to Singapore.

¹ If the traveller visits or transits through countries/regions in different categories, the most stringent set of requirements among those countries/regions will apply.

^{*} Countries/Regions may have vaccination-differentiated border measures.



Only non-Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents and Long-Term Pass Holders (LTPH) from Category I countries/regions may enter Singapore for short-term visits unless separately announced. LTPHs with passes issued by the Ministry of Manpower may have to comply with additional requirements and measures.

¹ Except Bangladesh, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka, where entry is currently not allowed for all long-term pass holders and short-term visitors. Only Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents with travel history to Bangladesh, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka are allowed entry into Singapore.

² To expedite the COVID-19 PCR test at the airport, travellers are strongly encouraged to register and pre-pay for their on-arrival COVID-19 PCR test prior to departing for Singapore at <https://safetravel.changiairport.com>

³ Travellers from identified Countries/Regions will have to undergo an on-arrival ART test, in addition to the on-arrival PCR test. Please check the SafeTravel website for details.

⁴ Please note that vaccinated travellers of the same travel party with unvaccinated children (aged under 12 years old) can apply to serve their 14-day SHN together at their place of residence or other suitable accommodation. The unvaccinated children will be subjected to the prevailing testing regime, i.e. children aged 3 and above will undergo a D-14 PCR test.

⁵ The cost of ARTs is S\$40 (inclusive of GST) for 4 kits per person serving SHN aged 3 and above in the calendar year. ART swabbing is required for travellers serving SHN at dedicated SHN facilities.
