1 In 2015, nearly 4.4% of European workers were working in agriculture.

2 Almost three-quarters (72.8%) of the EU-28 agricultural labour force is concentrated in seven countries: Romania, Poland, Italy, France, Spain, Bulgaria and Germany.

3 Agriculture is the fifth largest employer of men in the EU and the seventh largest employer of women.

4 Agriculture is ranked as one of the three most hazardous sectors together with mining and construction (Approx. 500 fatal and 160.000 non-fatal accidents every year in agriculture in the EU) Source : Eurostat, 2016

- developed by International Social Security Association
- A **process** – rather than a target
- A **transformational approach** to prevention
- Building a **culture of prevention** that integrates both **safety, health and well-being at work**
