Agriculture in Europe







- 1 In 2015, nearly 4.4% of European workers were working in agriculture.
- Almost three-quarters (72.8%) of the EU-28 agricultural labour force is concentrated in seven countries: Romania, Poland, Italy, France, Spain, Bulgaria and Germany.
- Agriculture is the fifth largest employer of men in the EU and the seventh largest employer of women.
- Agriculture is ranked as one of the three most hazardous sectors together with mining and construction (Approx. 500 fatal and 160.000 non-fatal accidents every year in agriculture in the EU) Source: Eurostat, 2016

- A transformational approach to prevention
- Building a culture of prevention that integrates both safety, health and well-being at work





